FUNDING INTERESTS

The Langley School District Foundation with its endowments and fund raising activities supports the Langley School District and the next generation of life-long learners. All Foundation funds go directly towards the funding of Langley School District projects. Staffing and administrative costs are funded by revenues from the International Student Operations.

Funding Interests include:

- Literacy in all its forms
- Enriched performing and visual arts initiatives
- Special education programs and needs
- Summer programs such as PALS, REC 'N READING and READY, SET, LEARN
- Purchase library books and technology equipment
- Supporting innovative learning enhancement projects

Priority is given to initiatives that are innovative and have system-wide potential.

The Foundation Does Not Fund:

- 100% of a project's cost
- retroactive funding
- school construction
- daily operations
- on-going initiatives where money is required on a continual basis in order to operate
- salaries
- travel expenses & conference fees
- speaker honorariums & expenses
- requests that originate outside the school district

The Foundation will consider all requests that meet the criteria. Please include the following information:

TIME LINES

The Foundation currently has three funds designated to support music, special needs and literacy in all its forms. These funds will grow over the years, but because they have only recently been received, foundation funds are currently limited. At this time, the foundation is accepting requests in the amount of \$1000 to \$7500. Only written applications will be considered. The Foundation reviews applications twice a year in the Fall and Spring. Fall deadline is October 15. Spring deadline is March 15.
